

Tender By-Law #22

This is a By-Law regarding Tendering in the Village of Gagetown.

Tenders shall be called for:

1. All work for which a contractor is to be used.
2. Positions which have not previously been filled.
3. For previously tendered positions unless Council is in favour of renewing the existing tender.


THEN:

1. A letter is sent to the Co./Person offering renewal and stating the amount of the remuneration and length of the renewed tender.
2. "Salary" is negotiable.
3. If Council and/or Co./Person is not satisfied with the negotiations, a new tender may be called.

Tender notices:

1. Shall be sent out one month prior to closing date
2. Shall be posted at local retail outlets and letters sent to previous bidders.
3. Shall include type of job, how to obtain specifications, closing time and date.
4. Preference will be given to Village residents.
5. Lowest Tender may not necessarily be accepted.
